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EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD

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CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, MASSACHUSETTS


Pursuant to my authority as Chief Executive Officer of Springfield, I hereby establish a local arts lottery council for the City of Springfield, in accordance with G.L. c.10, §35C. The said local arts lottery council shall have the power outlined in G.L. c.10, §35C and regulations issued by the Massachusetts Arts Lottery Council. The said local arts lottery council shall be known as the Springfield Arts Lottery Council.

The Springfield Arts Lottery Council shall consist of thirteen members who shall each be appointed for a term of two years but shall not be appointed to more than three consecutive terms. The terms of all Springfield Arts Lottery Council members shall begin July 1 and end June 30. All members of the Springfield Arts Lottery Council shall be residents of the City of Springfield.

The City Clerk shall keep record of the Springfield Arts Lottery Council members and their terms, as with other local Boards and Commissions. The City Clerk shall swear in all Springfield Arts Lottery Council members.

The Springfield Arts Lottery Council may establish, and from time to time issue or revise as necessary guidelines, rules, rulings or regulations as it may deem necessary or desirable to interpret or carry out the purposes of section 35C of chapter ten of the General Laws and any guidelines, rules, rulings or regulations issued by the Massachusetts Arts Lottery Council.

This Executive Order supersedes the Mayoral Executive Order issued by me and filed with the City Clerk on March 6, 1985.
