The Secretary of Energy & Environmental Affairs will publish notice of the EENF in the Environmental Monitor, will receive public comments on the project for 30 days, and will then decide, within ten days, if an Environmental Impact Report is needed. A remote site visit or video consultation session on the project may also be scheduled.
