The CoC Scoring and Ranking Committee decided to reduce this grant because the grant had slow-spending in the last fiscal year. The Committee made the strategic decision to reduce this grant in order to allow the CoC to fund a new project which will provide 36 units of permanent supportive housing for chronically homeless individuals.

The project applicant was notified of the decision to reduce this grant on Sept. 12, 2023.


