### EXECUTIVE ORDER

#### BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD

Pursuant to my authority as Chief Executive Officer of Springfield, I hereby establish a local cultural council for the City of Springfield, in accordance with G.L. c.10 s58C. The said local cultural council shall have the power outlined in G.L. c.10, s58C and regulations issued by the Massachusetts Cultural Council. The said local cultural council shall be known as the Springfield Cultural Council.

The Springfield Cultural Council shall consist of thirteen members who shall each be appointed for a term of three years but shall not be appointed to more than two consecutive terms. The terms of all Springfield Cultural Council members shall begin July 1 and end June 30. All members of the Springfield Cultural Council shall be residents of the City of Springfield. Members shall have demonstrated scholarship or creativity in, or distinguished service to, the arts, humanities, or interpretive sciences.

The City Clerk shall keep a record of the Springfield Cultural Council members and their terms, as with other local Boards and Commissions. The City Clerk shall swear in all Council members.

The Springfield Cultural Council may establish, and from time to time issue or revise as necessary guidelines, rules, rulings or regulations as it may deem necessary or desirable to interpret or carry out the purposes of section 58C of chapter ten of the General Laws and any guidelines, rules, rulings or regulations issued by the Massachusetts Cultural Council.

This Executive Order supersedes the Mayoral Executive Order issued on August 17, 1988 and filed with the City Clerk on August 18, 1988.
