## IMPORTANT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- We serve children between the ages of 6-13 (must be 6 by July 1<sup>st</sup> and not turn 14 before July 1<sup>st</sup>)
- Must be Springfield residents
- Can only be registered by parent or legal guardian. Legal guardian must show proof of guardianship.
- **Birth certificate for children must be presented.**
- We will not hold spots or make special arrangements. No exceptions.
- 75 spots per program available. First come first served.

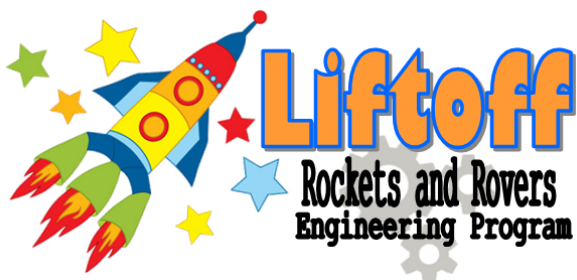
**Theme: Into the Wild**

**Theme: Lift Off! Rockets and Rovers Engineering Program**
