

## End of Line Ahead For Old Tradition At Union Station

The positions of train caller and red cap will be eliminated at Union Station starting Monday, Division Superintendent Robert V. Brinkworth said on Friday.

Red cap service will be eliminated entirely, but train calling will go on, he said. A microphone will be installed in the luggage check room and the calling will be done from there, he said. The decision is a local effort to reduce expenses because of the economic condition of the B & A, he said.

There are three train callers and two red caps employed at the station. Lay-offs to allow for the reduced number of positions will depend on seniority, Brinkworth said.

The station is owned and operated by the Boston and Albany Division of the New York Central Railroad.
