

# CITY OF SPRINGFIELD POLICE CADET EXAM

PER ORDER OF THE POLICE COMMISSIONER, ON SATURDAY, OCTOBER 24, 2009 THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD POLICE DEPARTMENT WILL BE CONDUCTING A WRITTEN EXAMINATION FOR FUTURE APPOINTMENTS TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S CADET PROGRAM. ALL CANDIDATES MUST MEET THE MINIMUM CRITERIA. PROPER IDENTIFICATION MUST BE PRODUCED BEFORE BEING ALLOWED TO TAKE THE EXAM. ANY SPRINGFIELD RESIDENT WHO MEETS THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS MAY APPLY, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, 8:00 A.M. TO 3:30 P.M, IN THE RECORDS DIVISION OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, 130 PEARL STREET, SPRINGFIELD, MA. 01105. ***THE LAST DAY TO APPLY WILL BE WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 21,2009.*** IDENTIFICATION AND PROOF OF RESIDENCY, ALONG WITH A COPY OF THE APPLICANT'S BIRTH CERTIFICATE, MUST BE PROVIDED AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION. ## **MINIMUM CRITERIA FOR APPLYING TO TAKE THE EXAMINATION:**

- 1). Resident of the City of Springfield, Ma. at the time of application.
- 2). Citizen of the United States of America.
- 3). Must be between the ages of 17 1/2 and 21 1/2 years of age on the date of the examination.
- 4). Be of good moral character, without any felony criminal convictions.
- 5). Present a high school diploma or school counselor letter stating that the applicant will be graduating at the end of the current school year.
- 6). Must be licensed to operate a motor vehicle in the Commonwealth prior to being appointed.
- 7). Must be able to work full time when appointed to the cadet program.
- 8). Must be capable of passing a physical examination equal to that necessary for appointment as a police officer in the Commonwealth.
- 9). Must enroll in a college program and be awarded an associate degree in law enforcement or criminal justice or equivalent number of credits awarded in a four year program before completion of the cadet program.
