Building Division Highlights for Month of December

- Building Division issued 107 construction permits to Erect, Alter, Repair or Demolish with an estimated construction value of \$1,781,514.80 for the month of December with a fiscal year to date total of \$63,336,088.71
- Fiscal year to date, the building division has issued new construction permits for 39 new, single family dwellings, and 657 residential permits to add to and alter single family or two family dwellings, 54 new construction permits for non residential buildings, 222 permits to add to and alter a nonresidential building and 45 permits to demolish a structure.
- Special attention was given to fast track the Building Permit for \$104,825.00, alter an office building for tenant buildout, (1414 Main Street, 8th Floor) \$147,770.00, alterations for new office space and storage room (300 Cadwell Drive) \$232,000.00, interior remodel for Raymour & Flanigan, (635-665 Boston Road).




Building Revenue Trend Analysis FY 2004-2010 Month of December 2009 Total \$79,476.00
