## CODE ENFORCEMENT DEPARTMENT

#### **Building Division Highlights for Month of August**

- Building Division issued 172 Construction permits to Erect, Alter, Repair or Demolish with an estimated construction value of \$18,893,287.06 for the month of August with a fiscal year to date total of \$26,619,177.06.
- Fiscal year to date, the building division has issued new construction permits for 7 new single family dwellings, 1 two family dwellings and 193 residential permits to add to and alter a single family or two family dwellings, 38 new construction permits for non residential buildings, 74 permits to add to and alter a nonresidential building and 15 permits to demolish a structure.
- Special attention was given to fast track the Building Permit for \$13,000,000.00 to erect a new multi tenant medical/office building (100 Wason Avenue), \$1,050,000.00 to erect a new Golden Corral Buffet & Grill Restaurant (436 Parker Street).
- **Condemned:** 76 Mill Street and 163 Bloomfield Street due to Building code violations. The tenants were placed in temporary housing and all of the owner's properties will be given to a receiver to manage.
- 192-194 Quincy Street-This property was condemned due to a fire. The tenants have been placed in emergency housing units and we are working with the owners for the repairs to the structure.

#### **ZONING DIVISION**

- W.S. Bruce Street, Parcel #12 and 44 Bruce Street, were used for an illegal auto repair business and an illegal junkyard. The City has gained compliance through court action.
- We have conducted a targeted sweep of all properties on Marble Street. (Per City Stat, South End). Some of the violations on the street range from blight, unsafe foundation without a permit, illegal junkyard, run down garage and a building that needs to be demolished.
- 18 Decatur Street caught fire and was condemned. The tenants have been placed in temporary housing and the property is boarded and secured. The property is in court and the City is seeking a demolition or rehabilitation plan.
- 65-67 Holly Street had someone sleeping in a makeshift basement apartment that was condemned. The tenant has vacated, and the basement was completely cleaned out. Attached photo.
- Seventy-two (72) special Saturday inspections were performed on August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 9th, 16<sup>th</sup>, 23, 30th to target illegal auto repairs and sales, parking of tractor trailers in neighborhoods, illegal junkyards, illegal scrap metal business, illegal landscaping business, class I, II, and III license renewals, chickens & roosters and targeted sweeps of problematic neighborhoods.




## Building Revenue Trend Analysis FY 2004-2009 Month of August 2008 Totals - \$291,691
