BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD
EMERGENCY ORDER

*Municipal
Hospital*

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield owns and operates a chronic care facility located at 1400 State Street, Springfield, Massachusetts, known as the Springfield Municipal Hospital ("Hospital"); and

WHEREAS, due to unforeseen circumstances, the Hospital no longer has a Rehabilitation Therapist to provide services to the patients at the Hospital; and

WHEREAS, rehabilitation services are both essential to the proper treatment of patients and required by Federal and State regulations; and

WHEREAS, immediate action is required to provide for the continued availability of these services to the patients at the Hospital.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICHARD E. NEAL, Mayor of the City of Springfield, do hereby declare, on this 13th day of June, 1985, that such facts constitute a case of special emergency involving the health and safety of the patients at the Springfield Municipal Hospital and hereby authorize the execution of a contract with Valley Rehabilitation, Inc., or such other entity secured by the Purchasing Agent for the City, for the provision of rehabilitation services at the Springfield Municipal Hospital.
