You must be 18 years of age or older and a legal and approved RESIDENT of Boston Road Mobile Home Park whose name appears on the park register as homeowner and must show a picture I.D. All Owners will have 1 ballot.

To avoid any confusion on the day of the election, you may want to check with the office to ensure your name is on the list provided to us by Management. **ON THE DAY OF THE ELECTION ONLY NAMES ON THE LIST WILL BE ALLOWED TO VOTE.**

To request an absentee ballot please leave your name and address at the BRMHP office. All requests for absentee ballots must be requested before **Monday, October 31, 2022.**
