Year-to-Date Calls for Service/Offenses involving Carregan's Lounge (155 Maple St)

Calls for Service

- Between January 1, 2018 and June 22, 2018, SPD officers have responded to or initiated a total of 66 calls for service within 60 feet of **155 Maple St (Carregan's)**:
- Of these calls, **11** involved acts of violence
- **9** calls involved Shots Fired or ShotSpotter (this increases to **16** Shots Fired/ShotSpotter calls if the radius is expanded to 500 ft)
- Below is the breakdown of the remaining calls for service:
 - 2 Alarm Calls
 - 3 Assist Calls
 - 3 Ambulance Assist
 - 1 Suspicious Person
 - 3 Traffic Stop
 - 1 Unnecessary Noise
 - 1 Vandalism
 - 27 Directive Patrols
 - 4 Administrative/Supervisor Checks

Offenses

- Between January 1, 2018 and June 22, 2018, there were **8** reported victims of Aggravated Assaults at 155 Maple St (Carregan's):
 - One of the assaults involved homophobic slurs and an attack against victim who suffered a jaw that was broken in several places.
 - **4** incidents involved victims being shot (total of **5** victims).
 - In one incident, a victim was stabbed.

- One incident involved a victim who was jumped, beaten, and pistol-whipped; this altercation ended in shots fired.
- On 6/22/18 at 0143 hrs, officers responded to a ShotSpotter activation in the area. They located a victim whose vehicle had been struck by gunfire following an argument in the Carregan's parking lot. This resulted in an additional 2 intended victims (not included above). This is still under investigation.
- There were (2) Motor Vehicle Thefts during the January 1, 2018 to June 22, 2018 time period.
- Finally, an individual overdosed on Fentanyl while at Carregan's in May 2018.
