City of Springfield Observes "One Boston Day"

Springfield, MA- The City of Springfield will observe a moment of silence this afternoon at 2:49 p.m. to honor those affected by the April 15, 2013 Boston Marathon Bombing.

Mayor Domenic J. Sarno said, "We continue to stand with those affected families, first responders, and public safety professionals in marking this solemn event. We are all Boston Strong."

Boston Mayor Martin J. Walsh issued a proclamation this week which permanently designates April 15 as "One Boston Day," to commemorate those impacted by the bombings, and also to celebrate the resiliency and strength demonstrated by the people of Boston and around the world in response to the tragedy.
