

2025-2026 Springfield Recycling Info

For all Residents with Municipal Trash Collection
All items must be out by 6:30AM

Single Stream Recycling means
Paper & Containers are all together now!

You no longer need to separate paper and containers! Continue to rinse containers.

- ▲ Paperbacks & phone books
- ▲ Junk mail – windowed envelopes are OK.
- ▲ Boxboard – cereal, shoe, cracker boxes, etc.
No waxed paper, pizza boxes.
- ▲ Newspapers/ inserts, magazines/catalogs
- ▲ Brown paper bags
- ▲ White and colored paper
- ▲ Computer paper
- ▲ Corrugated cardboard – Flatten, tie in 3'x3' bundles, no tape. No waxed cardboard.
- ▲ Shredder paper – place in paper bags
- ▲ All paper and cardboard must be clean & dry.
- ▲ No soda or beer holders.
- ▲ No plastic grocery/newspaper bags

- ▲ Glass bottles/jars, all colors and sizes–
Please remove and discard all caps. No broken or other glass such as light bulbs, window or auto glass, dishes, glasses, Pyrex, ceramics.
- ▲ Aluminum, tin/steel cans and lids, aerosol cans and aluminum foil –
No paint or or other metal items.
- ▲ All plastic bottles, jars, tubs and plastic microwave trays/containers – No plastic bags, containers over 2 gal., motor oil, chemical or foam containers or flower pots.
- ▲ Milk & juice cartons (tent top), drink boxes – Place in bin with other containers.

RECYCLING COLLECTION SCHEDULE

Recycling bins are collected every other week on your regular trash collection day. All A Weeks are collected during boxed weeks on calendar below. All B Weeks are collected during highlighted weeks .

YARD WASTE COLLECTION SCHEDULE

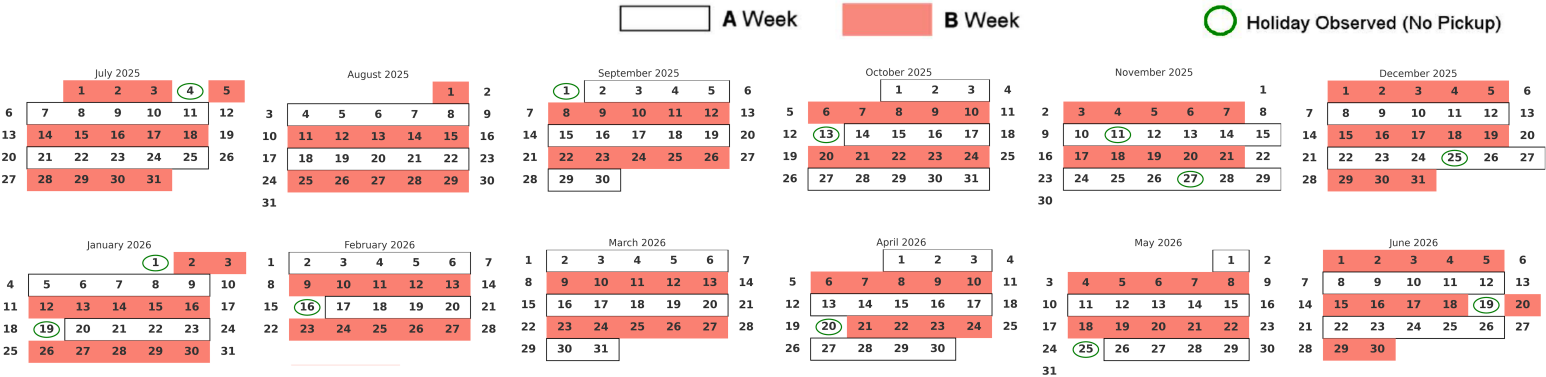
Curbside collection of yard waste will also follow this recycling schedule from April - Mid-December, weather permitting.

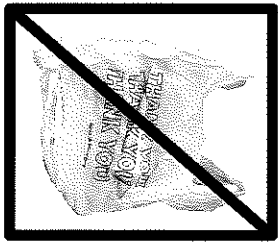

these materials OUT.

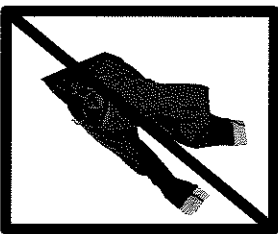
