Secondary Consideration

Form: Pyramidal

Flower: Small cones on male trees

Fruit: Blue-purple berry

Fall Color: Evergreen

Tolerates: Salt, Pollution, Drought, Shade

Growth Rate: Moderate

Size: Medium

Native Region: Eastern & Central North America

Notes: Exfoliating bark; Deer-resistant; Attracts many bird species
