

Eastern Red Cedar

Juniperus virginiana



Form: Pyramidal

Flower: Small cones on male trees

Fruit: Blue/purple berry

Fall Color: Evergreen

Tolerates: Salt, Pollution, Drought, Shade (when young)

Growth Rate & Size: Moderate; Medium

Native Region: Eastern & Central North America

Notes: Exfoliating bark; Part of cedar-apple rust pathogen cycle; Deer-resistant; Attracts many bird species
