\*PRE-COURSE SKILLS TEST will be held before the course begins. Candidates will need to bring a swimsuit, towel, sweatshirt (& optional goggles) and be prepared to pass the following:

SWIM 300 YARDS (12 lengths of a 25 yd. Pool)

- SWIM 20 YARDS using either front crawl or breaststroke, surface dive, retrieve 10 lb. object, & return to the surface, and swim 20 yards back to the starting point with the object.
  - 2 Minute Tread without support and without stopping using your legs only.
