SPRINGFIELD - Workers have erected the steel frame for the new 75,000-square - foot, \$20 million office building for

**Hampden County Physician Associates and Sisters of Providence Health System.**

The building at Carew and Chestnut streets will house the Weldon Rehabilitation Hospital's outpatient rehabilitation programs, Mercy Hearing Center and two Mercy-affiliated physician practices.

The new building will be handicapped accessible.
