

# FREE BREAKFAST FOR SMITH COLLEGE GUESTS

## Tables Set on Platform of Union Station for Those Who Left Early

Northampton, June 16—Smith college speeded the parting guests of its 50th anniversary celebration and commencement by the unusual attention of serving a free breakfast at the Union station. Tables were set up on the station platform and all present, including not only guests of the college, but townspeople and commuters, leaving on the early morning trains, were served. The catering was done by Fitzpatrick Bros of Malden, who catered at the college, and their corps of waiters.

The railroads and their local officials have given efficient attention to the requirements of the thousands of college guests. Extra coaches were attached to all trains yesterday and four extra sleepers were attached to the New York train last night. The Western Union company has maintained an instrument on the station platform nearly a week. The arrangements for special protection made by the police department were so completely successful, especially in dealing with the great number of automobiles, that not one accident happened.
