The City of Springfield is receiving \$1.7 million in HOME Investment Partnership Program funds from prepayment of a housing development loan. In order to address emergency housing needs caused by the Covid-19 pandemic, the City will use the funds to provide emergency short-term rental assistance and utility payments to Springfield households who have experienced a loss of income due to Covid-19. The funds will be made available as HOME program Tenant-Based Rental Assistance (TBRA) to households with an annual income of no more than 80% of the area median income.
