ABSTRACT

The Springfield Police Department, 130 Pearl Street, Springfield, Massachusetts respectfully submits this grant application pursuant to the criteria outlined in the 2012 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Formula Program: Local Solicitation.

The title of this project is the **Springfield Police Department “2012 Equipment and Technology Upgrade”**.

The goal of this project is to identify and replace and/or upgrade obsolete systems and equipment in support of the delivery of law enforcement/public safety services. The obsolete systems and equipment were identified in multiple meetings with various department heads and stakeholders.

Subsequent to these meetings, additional meetings were held with respect to the identification of technology in which members of the general public were in attendance.
