

## Section Two: Register a Camera

- Registering your home or business security cameras indicates to law enforcement that you are willing to assist in an investigation if something happens in view of your registered cameras.
- Those who have registered a camera will be contacted directly by police only if it is believed that footage may be helpful to an investigation. Registering security cameras does *not* provide police with direct access to the camera or its footage.






